



DRESS CODE

A reasonable dress code supports the goal of self-esteem, neatness and good grooming. Evidence is available which shows that young people are apt to succeed more when their self-esteem is uplifted by a good personal appearance. There are also other practical considerations. Students behave better, are spared unnecessary peer competition in dress, and are saved from the indecision of wondering what to wear each day when there is a fair dress code in effect. The school has attempted to provide a dress code that is both flexible and suitable to our purposes. Parents are expected to assist the school in encouraging their son/daughter to abide by the dress code.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform must be purchased through FLYNN & O'HARA.

REQUIRED FOR GIRLS

*Information will be provided by local school in the addendum.

REQUIRED FOR BOYS

*Information will be provided by local school in the addendum.

Nothing may be worn over the boy's shirt or the girl's blouse except the school uniform sweater or sport coat (where applicable.) No other sweater may be worn. In addition the following dress code will be applied:

1. Boys must be clean-shaven, their hair must be clean, neatly combed, and cut above the collar and behind the ears and eyebrows must be visible.
2. Girls may not wear make up or excessive jewelry. Piercings (other than traditional earrings) are not permitted. Boys may not wear any unusual jewelry -- no earrings or necklaces (which are visible). Boys may not wear pierced jewelry of any kind. Hats may not be worn in the building.
3. Unusual haircuts and/or hair color are not permitted for boys or girls.

4. Students who are not in complete uniform may be given a detention.
5. It is advised that all students should have their names put on all parts of their uniforms.

OUT-OF-UNIFORM_DAYS

Out-of-Uniform days are an occasional privilege. Like all privileges, their beneficial effects can be forfeited because of the irresponsibility of a few. Out-of-Uniform days are time to show school spirit, wear the school colors, dress up or just enjoy a change of pace. Out-of-Uniform means a relaxed attitude toward dress, which does not result in extremes.

Clothes worn on Out-of-Uniform days must be modest in all circumstances.

Explicitly excluded as suitable wear on any Out-of-Uniform days are shorts, skorts or culottes, mini skirts, sleeveless shirts, tank, tube, or midriff tops, torn, ripped or patched clothes, or sweat pants. Both girls and boys should wear shoes and socks. No student will be permitted to wear open-toed/backless (NO CLOGS) sandals. Violators will be sent home to change and will lose the privilege of being Out-of-Uniform.

NOTE:

The Administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate for the Dress Code.



SCHOOL UNIFORMS REQUIRED FOR GIRLS

Girls Grades Kindergarten through 3rd

Winter Uniform (November 1st Through April 1st)

Navy & plaid jumper.
Navy skort.
Navy slacks.
Khaki pleated slacks.
White long or short sleeve blouse with Peter Pan collar.
Navy or white polo with logo long or short sleeve.
Navy crew neck cardigan with Holy Family logo.
Navy long sleeve pull over with Holy Family logo.
Navy or white tights (ribbed or opaque).
Navy or white knee socks.

Spring / Fall Uniform (April 1st through November 1st)

Khaki Skort.
Khaki twill walking shorts (to the knee).
Navy or white short sleeve polo with Holy Family logo.
Navy, white, khaki crew socks.

Girls Grade 4th to 8th

Winter Uniform (November 1st through April 1st)

Navy and khaki plaid kilt (appropriate length).
Navy or khaki 2 panel skort.
navy or khaki girls slacks.
White short or long button down collar blouse.
Navy or white, long or shod sleeve polo with Holy Family logo.
Navy V-neck pullover long sleeve sweater with Holy Family logo.
Navy V-neck sweater vest with Holy Family logo.
Navy or white ribbed or opaque tights.
Navy or white knee socks.

Spring/Fall Uniform (April 1st through November 1st)

Navy or khaki Z-panel skort.
Navy or khaki walking shorts (to the knee).
Navy or white short sleeve polo.

All Girls

No dying of hair or false nails.

Appropriate school shoes: No high heels, no open toe shoes, no clogs,

No sandals, no sneakers except on gym days.



School Uniform Required for Boys

Boys Grades Kindergarten through 8th

Winter Uniform (November 1st through April 1st)

Navy or khaki twill pants.

Navy or white long or short sleeve polo.

White short or long sleeve button down collar shirt.

Navy V-neck pullover sweater with Holy Family logo.

Navy V-neck sweater vest with Holy Family logo.

Navy button down cardigan with Holy Family logo.

Navy, white or beige crew socks.

Black/ brown belt.

Spring/Fall Uniform (April 1st through November 1st)

Navy or khaki twill walking shorts (to the knees).

Navy or white short sleeve polo with logo.

Navy, white or beige crew socks.

All Boys

No dying of hair.

Appropriate hair cuts no unusual colors.

No earrings.

Appropriate shoes: no sandals, no sneakers (except for gym), no hiking boots.

Gym Uniforms

Boys and Girls for Grades Kindergarten through 8th

Gold short sleeve shirt with Holy Family logo.

Gold sweatshirt with Holy Family logo.

Navy or black shorts or sweatpants.
Gym sneakers must have backs for safety reasons and no roller sneakers.
Students will wear their gym uniforms to school on their assigned day.

All Students:

Shoes which provide safety on the stairways, halls, and playground, etc.
Shoes or boots worn in snowy weather are not to be worn in the school building during the school day.

These should be changed prior to going to the classroom! for all children's health and safety.

Sneakers are to be worn on Gym Day only.

No "boot-type" shoes.

No "fad" haircuts or coloring permitted.

No earrings (boys): No Hanging earrings for girls): simple jewelry only.

NO body piercing except for girls' ear lobes.

No make-up.

Socks must be worn at all time, and must cover the ankle.

Sport socks for gym only.

Nail polish (girls) - clear or pastel colors only. NO Fake nails

No "add-on" hanging from school bags, for the safety of students.

No cargo pants or cargo shorts (no pockets on the outside).

No pull-along luggage type school bags (for safety concern on stairs, and storage).

UNIFORM VIOLATION

First Time - Students receives warning from teacher

Second Time - Parent is called to bring proper uniform.

Pre-School:

Clothing suitable for age level activities.

Dress Code for "Dress down Days"

Clothing should be appropriate for an educational setting.

The following restrictions need to be observed:

No halter-tops, tank tops, crop tops, or spandex or tight-fitting pants or shorts.

Any decorations on T-shirts should be appropriate.

Shorts must knee length. Otherwise, long pants or uniform shorts should be worn.
If sandals are chosen, they must be worn with socks. No Flip-flops for safety reasons.
