Dear HFA Families,

I would like to communicate our policy for school uniforms and the various types of “our uniform days” that are held during the school year. As you may or may not know, there are 5 different dress types that are used during the school year: regular uniforms, gym days, spirit wear, dress down and dress up/birthday. Each is addressed below so that everyone knows what is acceptable on each day type.

1. School Uniforms – Most days of the school year students must wear their school uniform.

Girls Grades K-8

- White or navy blue, long or short sleeve polo shirt
- Navy blue V-neck or cardigan sweater
- ALL Polo shirts and Sweaters MUST be embroidered with the Holy Family Academy Logo
- Khaki or navy blue uniform shorts (August-October and April-June)
- Khaki or navy blue uniform pants (November-March)
- Khaki or navy blue skorts
- Girls in grades K-3 may wear plaid jumpers purchased at Flynn O’Hara Uniforms or Lands’ End
- Girls in grades 4-8 may wear plaid skirts purchased at Flynn O’Hara Uniforms or Lands’ End
- White, blue or tan knee socks and hard sole solid colored shoes (brown, black, navy or tan)

Boys Grades K-8

- White or navy blue, long or short sleeve polo shirt
- Navy blue V-neck or cardigan sweater
- ALL Polo shirts and Sweaters MUST be embroidered with the Holy Family Academy Logo
- Khaki or navy blue uniform shorts (August-October and April-June)
- Khaki or navy blue uniform pants (November-March)
- White, blue or tan crew socks and hard sole solid colored shoes (brown, black, navy or tan)
- All boys in grades 6 – 8 are required to wear a white dress shirt with a button down collar and a tie of their choice with khaki pants and a belt on days when Liturgy is held.

PLEASE NOTE FOR BOTH GIRLS AND BOYS:

On regular uniform days only an HFA Logo V-neck sweater, cardigan or vest may be worn. No spirit wear sweatshirts or gym sweatshirts will be allowed to be worn in the classroom on those days. Hoodies may be worn to school as the students' jacket, but will not be allowed to be worn in classrooms during the school day with the only exceptions being noted below.

Polo shirts can also be purchased through Valley Athletics or you may purchase plain shirts/sweaters and have the HFA logo embroidered.


2. Pre-K Uniforms and K-8 Gym Uniforms (worn on assigned gym day)

Boys and Girls

- HFA logo short sleeve gym t-shirt
 - HFA logo sweatpants
 - HFA logo shorts (August-October and April-June)
 - Any HFA purchased sweatshirt (e.g. zip-up hooded, Under Armor, gold crew neck and sparkle crew neck)
 - Sneakers and white socks (socks must be seen above the sneaker).
- 3. Spirit Wear – We will have 2 scheduled spirit wear days per month. These days are designed to allow students to show their school spirit by wearing HFA Logo clothing. All t-shirts, sweatshirts and sweatpants that have an HFA Logo are acceptable on these days. No jeans or leggings/yoga pants are allowed to be worn on spirit wear days.**
- 4. Dress Down – Throughout the year dress down days will be used as fundraisers or rewards for students. On these days students may wear their favorite clothing with the understanding that all clothing must be appropriate in size and style for the school setting. No skirts of inappropriate length, tight stretch pants or yoga pants, low neck shirts or dresses, tank tops, halter tops will be allowed. Any sleeveless dresses or tops must have a sweater worn over it during the school day. Jeans will be allowed on dress down days.**
- 5. Dress Up/Birthdays – During the school year there are days where students may be out of the normal school uniform but are still required to dress up. Also, students may dress up to celebrate their birthday. On these days, students may wear dress pants or knee length skirts, dresses or shorts, dress shirt blouse or sweater and hard sole shoes. No skirts of inappropriate length, jeans, tight stretch pants or yoga pants, low neck shirts or dresses, tank tops, halter tops will be allowed. Any sleeveless dresses or tops must have a sweater worn over it during the school day.**
